

# Call for Abstracts

#### Information for Abstracts

Participants are required to sign up first to create their own ID and Password on the website of the EAFONS 2011 before submitting abstracts. After signing up, participants have access to 'My Page' by logging in to the website with the ID and Password they create. Then, it is available to submit and modify abstracts on the website.

The Scientific Committee will review abstracts after the deadline of abstract submission. Notification of abstract acceptance will be sent via e-mail to those who submit abstracts for the website. Accepted abstracts will be allocated to oral presentation or poster exhibition based on the submitters' choices.

#### **Important Dates**

#### Main Topics

 The Whole Field of Nursing Any topics associated with Nursing Science are welcome!

#### **How to Write Abstracts**

- 1. Abstracts must be written in English.
- 2. Abbreviations must be defined at the first time they appear before being used as an abbreviation in the text.
- 3. In preparation for abstracts, authors are advised to follow the structure below: [Original Article] Objectives Methods Results Conclusions
- 4. The title of abstract must contain less than 30 words.
- 5. The body of abstract must be no longer than 300 words.

Note that text beyond the limits will be truncated.

#### How to Submit Abstracts

- 1. Abstracts must be submitted through the website (www.eafons2011.org) only. Any abstract sent by mail or fax will not be processed by the Secretariat or forwarded to the Scientific Committee for review.
- 2. It is necessary to sign up and log in before abstract submission.
- 3. Presenting authors must sign up and register to participate in the Forum.
- 4. Please do not submit multiple copies of the same abstract.
- 5. Abstracts will be automatically edited on the website in accordance with the abstract format of the EAFONS 2011 once abstracts have been submitted.

#### Author's Responsibility

- 1. Authors are solely responsible for the contents of their abstracts. Any published abstracts will not be accepted.
- 2. Authors are responsible for any typing error on their abstracts.
